First Coast Women's Services is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit corporation that empowers women to make informed choices about their pregnancy. Our purpose is to prevent the tragedy of abortion by offering truthful education, emotional support, and practical assistance to individuals who are facing unplanned pregnancies. We present sexual abstinence as a positive lifestyle for singles and provide opportunity for healing and restoration to those who have been hurt by abortion. We share the love of Jesus in a caring non-judgmental environment. Services are free of charge and confidential, and we receive no government funding.

# Create a Layette Set

## What is it?

A layette is a set of new baby clothes, supplies, and accessories for a newborn decoratively placed in a plastic baby tub, packaged in tulle or cellophane to keep contents together.

## Ideas for Inside:

- Diapers, size 1
- Burp pads
- Bibs
- Crib sheets
- Onesies
- Receiving blankets
- Heavy blankets
- Sleepers (or gowns)
- Pair of socks/booties
- Hat/headbands
- Outfits

- Hooded towel
- Washcloths
- Baby wipes
- Pacifiers
- Teething toys
- Soft toys
- Baby bathtub
- Baby bottles
- Diaper cream
- Baby shampoo
- Baby lotion

## What is it?

FCWS Parents attending the Earn While You Learn (EWYL) Classes take classes on parenting, relationship skills, finances, and other topics and then earn points to "purchase" essential baby items. New parents, both moms and dads, love to earn diaper bags with all the essentials that new parents will need.

### What To Do:

- 1. Purchase a nice diaper bag for either mom or dad
- 2. Fill it with some or all of these newborn essentials: wipes, a baby care kit, baby mittens and socks, a thermometer, a pacifier, moisturizer, baby blankets, and onesies.

# "Real Men Change Diapers" Kit

### What Is It?

FCWS Dads attending the Earn While You Learn (EWYL) Classes take classes on parenting, relationship skills, finances, and other topics and then earn points to "purchase" essential baby items. New fathers love to earn daddy diaper bags with all the essentials that a new father will need when he's on "diaper duty."

#### What To Do:

- 1. Purchase a nice men's diaper bag
- 2. Fill it with some or all of these newborn essentials: diapers, wipes, a portable changing mat, diaper rash cream, a thermometer, pacifiers, teethers, moisturizer, baby blankets, and onesies.
- 3.Want to go the extra mile? Add in some fun gifts for the dad: gift cards, New Dad Survival Book, etc.

# Pray With Us!

There is no doubt that our most powerful weapon in the fight for life is prayer. While we need volunteers and hands-on involvement, we need your prayers most of all.

There are 4 ways to join us in prayer:

- Join the prayer text team Join thousands of prayer warriors across the First Coast in praying for our clients. When we have a client who is at-risk for abortion, we will send out a prayer alert. When we began this team, we saw the number of babies saved DOUBLE within the first year!
- Join us for Sanctity of Human Life Each January, churches across the community come together to pray and raise awareness for life. Join us at one of our several times of prayer and/or pray for life in our community on Sanctity of Human Life Sunday!
- Pray for our volunteers before a shift It is imperative that our volunteers be covered in prayer before they set about their life-saving work. It is always especially encouraging to have a local pastor come and minister to our volunteers in this way.
- Pray for FCWS in your services and small groups Praying as a congregation or group for life in our community is powerful beyond compare. We gain the most ground when we are united in seeking God for changed hearts and lives.
